EmploymentWorks Canada® (EWC) is a federally funded program offering employment preparedness training and job sampling work experience for individuals between 15 and 29 years old who have been diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

Eligibility requirements:

- Have a valid Social Insurance Number
- No longer in high school
- Not receiving or eligible for Employment Insurance
- Motivated to seek paid employment
- Average or near average academic skills

An initial screening assessment will be conducted to ensure appropriateness of program application.

Dates: January 17 to April 6, 2018 | May 8 to July 27, 2018 | September 11 to November 30, 2018 (12 Week Sessions)

Time: Structured learning sessions on Wednesdays from 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. and Worksite Sessions on Fridays between 9:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. (specific 2.5 hour slots TBD - days subject to change based on employer availability).
