WHAT IS EMPLOYMENTWORKS?

EmploymentWorks is a nationally funded program designed to support individuals who self-identify as having a disability to prepare for, get, and keep jobs.

WHO CAN TAKE PART? PERSONS WHO ARE:

- Over the age of 15
- Self-identified as Autistic and/or having another disability
- Motivated to find a job
- Able to **commit** to a schedule of 4 weeks, 5 days per week, 3 hours per day An initial screening assessment will be conducted to ensure appropriateness of program.

PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

EmploymentWorks summer program is condensed and allows you to complete the 3-month in-class learning and job sampling portion of the program in just 4 weeks. After you finish the 4 weeks, you will be able to get support with ongoing job club and job coaching.

This condensed **summer course** has been specially designed for high school students who are in school, just out of school, or are interested in completing the program over a shorter period of time.
