WHAT IS EMPLOYMENTWORKS?

EmploymentWorks is a nationally funded program designed to support individuals who self-identify as having a disability to prepare for, get, and keep jobs.

WHO CAN TAKE PART? PERSONS WHO ARE:

- Over the age of 15
- Self-identified as Autistic and/or having another disability
- Motivated to find a job
- Able to commit to a schedule of 4 weeks, 5 days per week, 3 hours per day

An initial screening assessment will be conducted to ensure appropriateness of program.

PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

EmploymentWorks summer program is condensed and allows you to complete the 3-month in-class learning and job sampling portion of the program in just 4 weeks. After you finish the 4 weeks, you will be able to get support with ongoing job club and job coaching.

This condensed summer course has been specially designed for high school students who are in school, just out of school, or are interested in completing the program over a shorter period of time.
