- Must have academic skills at grade 6 or higher
- Verbal abilities to handle fast-paced instruction
- Motivation to attend
- Must have at least one parent (or legal guardian) consistently available to attend sessions

An initial screening assessment will be conducted to ensure appropriateness of the program for the participant applying.
